What Happened?

The Federal Reserve <u>kept interest rates stable</u> and indicated they would be patient with future rate decisions.

<u>Trade talks</u> between the United States and China continue.

CEOs in the United States are <u>more worried about</u> <u>cybersecurity</u> than a possible recession according to a new survey by The Conference Board.

The World Bank forecasts global economic growth in 2019 to be 2.9%, down from 3.0% in 2018, while the International Monetary Fund predicts global economic growth to be 3.5% in 2019.

US government shut down temporarily ends after 35 days (the longest in history). A second shut down could occur on February 15th if a compromise on border security is not reached. Donald Trump is demanding legislation to fund a \$5.7 billion wall along the US/Mexico border.

Brexit deal <u>voted down</u> by UK Parliament. UK Prime Minister Teresa May now has to <u>secure concessions</u> with the European Union prior to the March 29th deadline.
