What Happened?

<u>Phase 1 of a trade deal</u> between the US and China is close to being finalized.

The 3 major US stock indices all <u>closed at record highs</u> in the final week of November.

Federal Reserve unlikely to move rates again this year.

Softbank reports first quarterly loss in 14 years.

Warren Buffet and Berkshire Hathaway are now holding a record \$128 billion worth of cash.

A Reuters poll of economists found a slim majority expect the Bank of Canada to keep the key interest rate at 1.75% to the end of 2020, while 4 of the top 5 major Canadian banks expect at least 1 interest rate cut.

The latest opinion poll for the British election on December 12th shows Boris Johnson's lead narrowing.

<u>Christine Lagarde</u> delivered her first policy speech as President of the European Central Bank.
