Did you know that 30% of phishing emails get opened?¹ Be wary of any links or attachments sent to you randomly, and ignore urgent requests for money or personal information.

HOW TO IDENTIFY A PHISHING EMAIL

The email isn't addressed to you.

2

The sender displays a sense of urgency or uses threatening language.

3

There are spelling and grammar errors.
